#### **Introduction**

- The objective of this meet is to adhere to the British Swimming philosophy of providing competition for all and to meet the mission statement "Every swimmer has the opportunity to swim in appropriate, quality competition to enable them to achieve their true potential".
- This competition is held under Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules.
- Venue- The venue is Buxton Swimming Pool, St Johns Road, Buxton SK17 6BE
- The meet is open to all members of Buxton Swimming Club and of such other local clubs as may be invited to take part.
- Meet entries are 400m - £6.00, 800 & 1500m - £10 per event .
- Age is on the last day of the meet - 9<sup>th</sup> December 2023
- Closing date for entries is midnight on Sunday December 3<sup>rd</sup> 2023
- Times are as stated in the programme of events but may vary and will be notified on the club website.
- Warm up may be split at the organizer's discretion.
- Dependent on entries the events maybe combined as mixed gender.
- All starts will be from the deep end of the pool.
- Over-the-top starts, and for Backstroke events side-by-side starts may be used at the referee's discretion .
- The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.

#### **Swimming/Spectator Area**

For the purpose of this meet, Team Managers will be responsible for the conduct of their swimmers. It is therefore expected that Team Managers will remain in the designated poolside area and/or with their swimmers at all times.

The following requirements should be brought to the attention of competitors, team staff and spectators. Entry to the swimmers' area is through the changing rooms and onto poolside. Entry to the spectators' seating area is from the entrance at the changing room end of the pool.

#### **Health and Safety**

The Promoters of this event will adhere strictly to the Swim England Health and Safety Laws. It should be noted that no-one will be permitted into the changing rooms, poolside or swimming/spectator seating area until the Promoters and/or Meet Referee are satisfied that the Health and Safety Rules have been met in full.

### **Data Protection**

All data relating to the entry and results processing will be held on a computer database. Results of the meet will be sent to Swim England within 5 working days for the purposes of ranking. Swimmer entries will be managed on a computer. By submitting entries, consent is thereby given as required by the Data Protection Act 1998, to the holding of personal information on computer. Personal data will be available for inspection during the meet upon request.

### **Photography**

Under Swim England child protection guidelines all coaches, chaperones and spectators wishing to use cameras, video or digital capturing device (including mobile phones) must first register their details on the approved form provided at the spectator entrance with proof of identity.
