Meet Conditions

The Meet will take place at ARC Leisure, Matlock on Saturday 8th and Sunday 9th June 2024 and will be swum under Swim England Regulations and Technical Rules of Swimming.

Anti-wave lane ropes and Daktronics electronic timing will be used.

Age groups for the Meet will be 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16 & over. Age at: 9th June 2024.

All events will be swum as Heat Declared Winners with all heats spearheaded.

Entries will only be accepted under the 'Upper Limit Times'.

The pool is eight lanes and 25m in length.

All officials will be qualified as required by the regulations for the level of meet licence.

Key Dates

Closing Date for Entries: Sunday 26th May 2024 (or when full if earlier)

Last date for Club Coordinators to report errors: Sunday 2nd June 2024

Dates of the Meet: Saturday 8th and Sunday 9th June 2024

Eligibility and Registration

All entrants must be eligible competitors as defined by Swim England Regulations and must be registered with Swim England by the closing date in the name of the club under which they wish to enter.

Swimmers may only compete for one club during the Meet.

The Girls category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Girls' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.

Fees

The Entry Fees are: £8.00 per event electronic entry, £9.00 per event individual entry
£10.00 per relay team entry

There are no refunds for withdrawals of accepted entries, unless due to injury (a medical note will be required).

Poolside Passes are: £25.00 for the weekend. poolside passes must only be used by suitably qualified and accredited persons.

Spectator Entry is: £7.00 for 1 session. (£5.00 for Concessions)
£12.00 for a full day (2 sessions). (£7.00 for Concessions)

Concessions are under 16 or 65 and over

No charge for children under 9.

Entries

Entries should, wherever possible, be submitted through the swimmer's club coordinator and receipt will be acknowledged via email.

Please make payment for entries payable to your club who will collate all the entries and forward one payment to Buxton Swimming Club.

An accepted entries list will be posted on the club website and emailed to club coordinators after the closing date. Club Coordinators must report errors by Sunday 2nd June 2024.

Entry times should be registered on the British Swimming Rankings database where possible.

Entry times, converted if necessary to a 25m pool via Sportsystems Entry Manager, must be equal to or slower than the Upper Limit Time for the event and age.

Times registered on the Masters Rankings database will be eligible for entry to the competition should they comply with the above entry conditions.

Entries will be accepted on a 'First Come, First Served, basis.

All relay events will be swum as 'Mixed' teams: defined as 2 Female and 2 Open/Male swimming in any order.

Swimmers can only swim in the relay events for the same club they are entered under in the individual events.

Entry times are needed with entries for all relay events. Names for relay team swimmers need to be submitted before the start of the warm-up for the session.

We reserve the right to limit entry numbers to the relay events to ensure the efficient running of the meet. Entries would initially be restricted by limiting the number of entries across all clubs and then on a first come first served basis .

Club Entries

The method of submission for entries is through the Sportsystems Entry Manager which is available for all clubs.

Para Swimmers

Buxton Swimming Club operates an inclusive policy for para swimmers in this competition. Swimmers will be ranked using British Para Swimming Points.

Awards will be made to the top three in each event

Para swimmers do not have to meet the qualifying time criteria.

Please choose events carefully and we will endeavour to ensure these are accepted given the time restraints of the event. Please contact the promoter for any further information and advice.

Please note: Para swimmers may not be able to enter using the electronic entry manager system. Clubs should email: entries@buxtonswimmingclub.co.uk for details of how to enter if this is the case.

Withdrawals

Swimmers are asked to withdraw if they will not be able to swim at the competition to avoid the meet being run with empty lanes.

Withdrawals must be made by 6.00 pm the day before for the next day's events.

Receipt of withdrawals may not be acknowledged.

Refunds

There will be no refunds for withdrawals after the closing date or the date the Meet is declared full unless due to injury where a medical note will be required.

Refunds will be sent to the swimmers club or direct to the swimmer if an individual entry.

Awards

Awards will be given to the first six swimmers in each age group for age groups 9,10,11 & 12 and the first three in each age group for 13,14,15 and 16 & over .

There will be a trophy for the club with the most points in the relay events.

Officials & Helpers

We need clubs to provide as many Officials and Helpers as possible to ensure this Meet can go ahead, run smoothly, and aid any mentoring of trainees.

We request that clubs provide officials and volunteers in at least the ratio of 1 per 10 swimmers as that is approximately how many are needed to run the meet. Please complete the 'Officials and Helpers Form', which can be found within this Meet Pack, with all information requested.

Refreshments will be provided for volunteers and officials who are working both of the sessions in a day. Mileage will be paid for officials and volunteers at the rates of 45 per mile or 25p per mile if accompanying a competing swimmer or swimmers.

We have technical and non-technical roles that we need to fill and most require no previous training. If you can spare your time to volunteer then please do to ensure a positive experience for the swimmers.

Notices

There is limited space available on poolside for swimmers and so there will be access to the Sports Hall for teams to congregate. The Sports Hall is for swimmers, team managers, coaches, and volunteers. Any parents wishing to meet their children should do so upstairs.

Swimmers need to bring camping chairs for use in the sports hall.

Clubs are required to provide a Team Manager in the Sports Hall to supervise their swimmers at all times during the Meet. It is expected that the Sports Hall will be always kept clean and tidy.

Any use of mobile phones or other devices is prohibited in changing rooms and changing areas whilst they are being used for an activity licenced by Swim England.

Spectators are not permitted to reserve seats in the seating balcony, nor are swimmers allowed in the spectator balcony during the Meet.

Coaches and Team Managers

Clubs are required to provide coaches and team managers to at least the minimum ratios required by wavepower - to supervise their swimmers at all times.

For poolside and sports hall access all coaches and team managers must be in possession of the free accreditation available from the member options section of www.swimmingresults.org

All clubs MUST ensure:

Swimmers are not left unsupervised on poolside or in the Sports Hall.

Swimmers do not go in the small pool as this pool will not be lifeguarded.

Swimmers report for their races in good time when called by the announcer.

Any injury or incident is reported to the pool staff and the Promoter.

Swimmers must be wearing appropriate footwear and be dry before leaving the pool area to return to the Sports Hall. The Sports Hall will be monitored but we ask that Team Managers ensure that swimmers behave appropriately throughout the meet.

Food is not allowed on poolside and should only be eaten in the Sports Hall or Cafe.

Swimmers must not get changed on poolside.

There are strictly no ball games in the Sports Hall.

Licence

This competition will be level 3 and licensed by Swim England for entry into Regional and County events. Licence Number: 3EM240289 The team events will not be licensed.

Admission to Meets

Buxton Swimming Club reserves the right to refuse admission to the Meet without having to state a reason.

Photography

Entrants should be aware that they may be photographed or filmed as part of this event. Those taking photographs must ensure that there is no flash and focus on their swimmer(s). Only the official event photographer (if appointed) will be allowed poolside to take photographs. This policy will be strictly enforced throughout the entire event. Leisure Centre policy, if different to this, will always take priority.

Covid

This event will be run in accordance with the latest Swim England, Government and Leisure Centre guidance in relation to Covid protocols.

The promoter will have to make such changes as are needed to the programme or to restrict numbers of entries at any time due to changes or conditions imposed by the pool operator or other authority.

Should the meet be cancelled due to Covid, a full refund of entry fees only will be made to the club under which you enter. Refund of entry fees will not be made in the event of spectators not being allowed.

By entering this competition, participants agree that we may publish their Personal Information as part of the results of the event and may pass such information to the governing body or affiliated organisation for the purpose of insurance, licences or for publishing results. Results may include (but not be limited to) name, any club affiliation, race times and age category.

A Cafe is available at the venue serving a full range of food and drinks. Seating is for customers with food purchased from the Café.

Please be aware there are limited parking spaces. Please park responsibly. Parking is available in the ARC car park. Cars must not be parked in the housing estate.

Neither Buxton Swimming Club or the pool management will be able accept any responsibility for loss or damage to personal property.

Any conditions not covered in this Meet Pack will be at the discretion of the Promoter. The promoter is solely responsible for the interpretation of the conditions contained in this meet pack and has the ability to vary them to ensure the safe and efficient running of the meet.

Please contact the Promoter with any queries at any time before, during or after the Meet.

The Referee's decision will be final on all matters relating to swimming and swimmer discipline. A secondary strobe light may be available for starting races at this venue if requested at the time of entry..

If sessions run over 3 hours, a 15-minute comfort break will be offered to officials.
